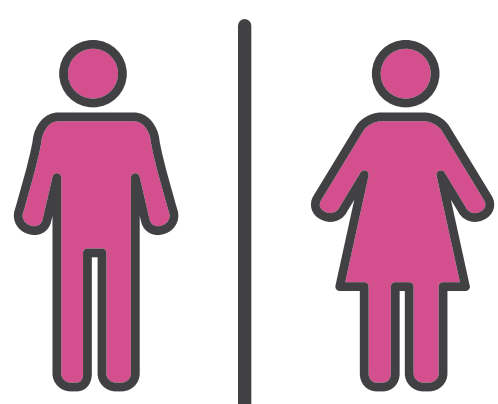




Arriving at The Oral Surgery Center:

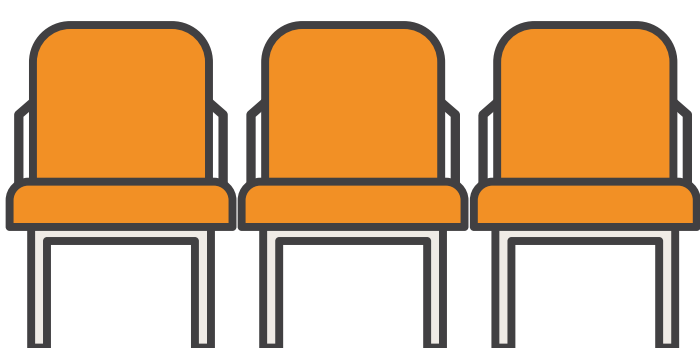

Preparation includes placement of a
surgical drape and monitoring equipment.

You will return to the
waiting area where we
ask you to remain until
your child's surgery is
complete.

After surgery your child will
transfer to a recovery room.

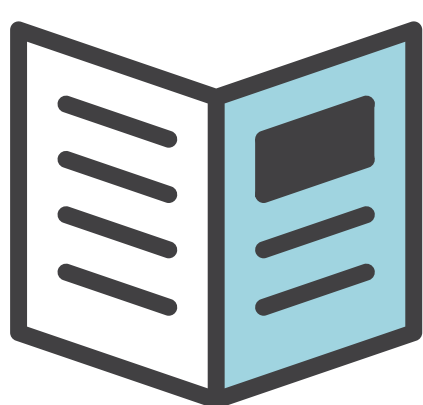

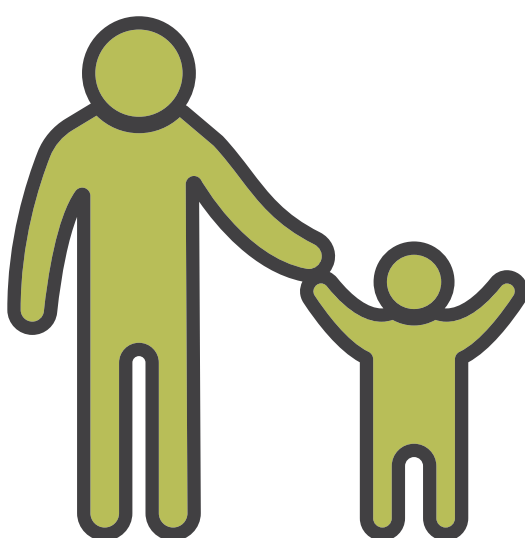
In the recovery room

pack on their cheek.

A surgical assistant will discuss homecare,
medications and what you may expect the
first week.

post-operative care
guide for your
reference.

home.

They are ready when they can sit up,
respond to questions, and walk out of our
